### PICASSO MUSEUM

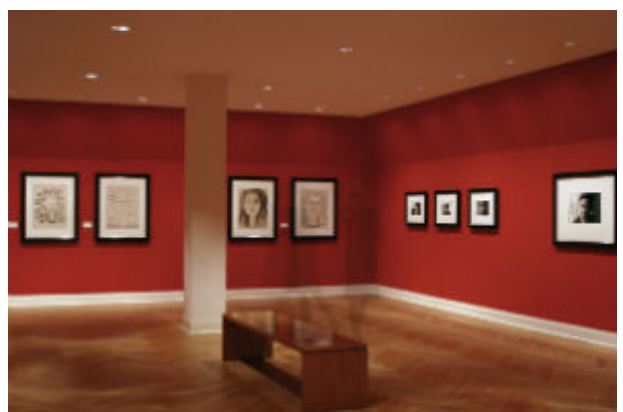
"This fascinating museum showcases a lot of lithographs by Picasso. But they also have regular rotating exhibitions by other artists that were doing work during the same time period."
